Predominantly known as an abstract painter and for his formative role in the New York School, Tworkov maintained a special regard for figure drawing throughout his career and kept a rigorous practice of it. His commitment to close, attentive looking while drawing from life resulted in an energetic and diverse style. Tworkov's figures range from minimal, loose and calligraphic to busy, fragmented and abstracted interpretations of the human form. This show is the first occasion that Tworkov's figures have been the subject of an exhibition.

Drawing the Figure will be accompanied by an illustrated brochure featuring an essay by Jason Andrew, Archivist and Curator of the Estate of Jack Tworkov, and excerpts from an interview with Jack Tworkov from 1960.
